RESOLUTION

Resolution in Support of the Adoption of the Mahoning County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

WHEREAS, the Mahoning County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan, on file in the office of the Director of the Mahoning County Emergency Management Agency, is a dynamic document, reflective of the extensive coordination and collaboration between various local, state and federal agencies, addressing Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation; and

WHEREAS, natural, technological, and manmade hazards can affect the City of Canfield; and

WHEREAS, significant structural, historical, and economic losses could result from an occurrence of a natural, technological, or man-made hazard events; and

WHEREAS, undertaking mitigation projects during pre-disaster periods could decrease the total losses the City of Canfield incurs as a result of said hazard occurrences.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, OHIO:

Section 1: The City of Canfield has partnered with the Mahoning County Emergency Management Agency to update the existing Mahoning County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazard Mitigation Plan, adopted in 2003, in effect to further identify, define, and characterize the hazards affecting the City as well as continue identifying and prioritizing projects that could lessen hazard vulnerability; and

Section 2: The City of Canfield has a strong interest in reducing losses from future hazard occurrences; and

Section 3: The hazard mitigation plan is a federal and state requirement to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding, and by that requirement, must be updated a minimum of every five (5) years; and

Section 4: A cooperative, joint effort is a proven, effective way to plan for and reduce hazard susceptibility in all government jurisdictions in Mahoning County, Ohio; and

Section 5: Therefore, the City of Canfield, joined Mahoning County in the completion of this plan update, and that the City of Canfield does hereby adopt the updated Mahoning County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan as presented and with any state/federally-required modifications; and

Section 6: That this Resolution and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Resolution were held in open meetings of this Council, all pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Municipality of Canfield.
