WHEREAS, the City of Canfield desires to purchase a vehicle pursuant to State Purchasing guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the following vehicle is available at the state purchase price:

- A. 2016 Ford F-350 regular Cab 4X4

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, OHIO:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to purchase a vehicle and equipment pursuant to the State Purchasing Bid Contract, price, and specifications from Fairway Ford,

Section 2: The cost of said purchase of:

- 1. 2016 Ford F-350 Regular Cab 4X4 shall not exceed \$29,568.00

Funding is available in the CM & R Capital Outlay Fund.

WHEREAS, the City has been a party to a two countywide Mutual Aid Agreement for Police services; and

WHEREAS, the current Mutual Aid Agreement has expired; and

WHEREAS, the City deems it to be in its best interest to enter into a new Mutual Aid Agreement, pursuant to which Mahoning and Trumbull County Police Departments will provide mutual aid to each other as necessary when such aid is available and warranted, all in accordance with Section 505.431, 737.041 and 3345.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1: That the City deems it to be in the best interest of the City to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement with the other police departments of Mahoning and Trumbull County.

Section 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute such agreement in the form and manner attached hereto:
