 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A JOINT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT WITH CANFIELD TOWNSHIP
WHEREAS, the City of Canfield and Canfield Township have negotiated the terms of an agreement for a joint economic development district ("JEDD" known as the Millennial Moments Joint Economic Development District, and
WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Agreement for the Millennia Moments Joint Economic Development District with Canfield Township pursuan to Ohio Revised Code Section 715.70 and related sections of the Ohio Revised Code, and
WHEREAS, the City has previously conducted a public hearing regarding the proposed JEDD Agreement as required by ORC Section 7.15.70(D)(2).
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANFIELD, OHIO:
 Section 1. Subject to Canfield Township approval of (i) the Millennia Moments JEDD Agreement and (ii) the Annexation Agreement of the parties which was contemporaneously negotiated, the City of Canfield shall enter into the Millennial Moments Joint Economic Development District Agreement with Canfield Township in the form attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.
Section 2. That subject to the contingencies stated in Section 1, the City Manager of the City of Canfield is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the Millennial Moments Joint Economic Development District Agreement attached hereto and to take any and all other actions as may be required by law to effect the terms of the Agreement.
