AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 927 OF
THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF CANFIELD, OHIO (REGARDING WATER RATES FOR 2015).
WHEREAS, the City of Canfield operates a water distribution system, purchasing
water from the City of Youngstown pursuant to a ten-year contract; and
WHEREAS, the City of Youngstown has notified the City of Canfield that
Canfield's water rates will increased by 8.75% each year for five consecutive years commencing in 2010 through 2014 and;
in 2010 unough 2014 and,
WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase water rates now effective January 1, 2015.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF CANFIELD, OHIO:
Section 1: Effective with all water billed after January 1, 2015, Chapter 927.01 of
the Canfield Code relating to water rates shall be amended to read as follows:
