

#### **CURRENT UNIFORMS**

\$51, 986.00 for 185 coats, pants, and hats

These uniforms were purchased after nearly a two-year fundraising effort chaired by then Canfield Band Parent President Evana Delon. After the uniforms were purchased in 2000, Mrs. Delon and the Canfield Band Parents began a Uniform Fund in which 10% of all band booster fundraising profits were put in this fund to purchase the next set of uniforms. Twelve years later, the fund currently has enough money to purchase these new uniforms with a small carry over amount (after the purchase of new hat boxes and plumes) for the next set of uniforms in 10-12 years. This is includes a 4% pre-pay discount on 90% of total and 7 free uniforms

(a \$2,413.60 value)

#### About the new uniforms. . .

- design includes elements of both traditional and modern band uniforms
  - horizontal stripes with silver buttons taken from the traditional West Point uniform
  - design was a collaboration of directors, students, and parents
  - Canfield Band Parents approved design and purchase
- material is Xtreme Dry Polyester which is much lighter but just as durable as our current Dacron-Wool blend
- addition of 12" plume and striping on pant creates a bolder and accented look on the field
- like the current uniforms, life expectancy is 10-12 years

#### MISC.

- 1. One other competitive bid was submitted by an out-of-state company, The Bandsman Company (Romeoville, IL.), for the amount of \$70, 161.55.
- 2. Old uniforms will be made into commemorative pillows and sold for \$50.00 each (see sample)
