

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC SALE OF EQUIPMENT NO LONGER USED BY THE VILLAGE OF POLAND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Motion to waive the three readings and pass by emergency

WHEREAS, the Village of Poland, Mahoning County, Ohio recognizes the need to sell the following listed equipment and vehicles at the earliest possible date:

- 2007 Dodge Charger
Not running, bad motor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Poland, Mahoning County, Ohio:

- Section I. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to advertise for sealed bids on the above listed vehicles.
- Section II. That the vehicles be sold "as is".
- Section III. That Poland Village Council reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and to waive any irregularities in the bidding. All sealed bids shall be labeled as to their intent.
- Section IV. The vehicles will be available for inspection during regular business hours.
- Section V. The successful bidder shall make full payment within seventy-two (72) hours of the award of the bid. Unsuccessful bids will be retained as backup bids in case of default.
- Section VI. A copy of this ordinance shall be entered into the official records of the Village of Poland, Ohio.
- Section VII. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Poland, Mahoning County, Ohio, and for further reason that the immediate effectiveness of this ordinance is required to comply with the Village's day to day business.
- Section VIII. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
