190219-10 Null	Being an ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and enter into contract for the sale of one use 2010 Jeep Grand Cherokee.
190305-13 Null	Being an ordinance to supercede ordinance no. 180306-16 establishing and adjusting salaries, wages and other benefits for non-represented city employees and non-represented city and elected officials of the city of Salem repealing all prior inconsistent ordinances herewith and declaring an emergency.
190305-14 Null	Being an ordinance to supercede ordinance no. 180306-17 setting and amending employee fringe benefits for non-represented employees and city officials repealing all prior inconsistent ordinances herewith and declaring an emergency.

PERSHING STREET BETWEEN ELLSWORTH AVENUE EAST TO SOUTH LINCOLN AVENUE. ALL OTHER PROPERTIES THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED C-3 NOT IN THE REDUCED C-3 DISTRICT WILL BE DESIGNATED C-2 AS SET OUT IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT A.
