WHEREAS, the Treasurer established a maintenance fund ("Maintenance Fund") to implement the Maintenance Plan for the Western Reserve K-12 School facility, which will continue to be funded for the required time period, and

Ohio School Facilities Commission's Classroom Facilities Assistance Program (CFAP) and selected Lawhon & Associates as the maintenance plan advisor to prepare the required maintenance plan ("Maintenance Plan") for this building, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio School Facilities Commission policy requires that the Board acknowledge certain limitations on the use of funds in the Maintenance Fund for preventive maintenance and capital planning as described in the Board's Maintenance Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to give the required acknowledgments to approve the Maintenance Plan prepared by Lawhom & Associates for the Western Reserve K-12 School facility and approved by the Ohio School Facilities Commission on October 10, 2012, which approval by the Commission permits the District to use the maintenance funds for permitted plan expenses, and to authorize use of the funds for permitted expenses related to this classroom facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Western Reserve Local School District that

- (A) The board acknowledges the following limitations on the use of the Maintenance fund, as stated in the Ohio School Facilities Commission's Preventative Maintenance and Capital Planning Program Policy and Procedure Memorandum:
 - 1. Allowable uses for the Maintenance Fund shall be the maintenance and repair of the facility, including preventive maintenance, periodic repairs, and the replacement of facility components;
 - 2. Routine janitorial and utility costs, equipment supplies and personnel associated with daily housekeeping and site upkeep per normal and customary standards are not allowable expenditures under the parameters of the maintenance fund;
 - 3. The actual use of the maintenance fund according to the terms of the approved maintenance is subject to audit;
 - 4. A five (5) year capital plan should be updated on an annual basis, while the complete maintenance plan should be updated every five (5) years and approved by the Board.
- (B) The Board approves the Maintenance Plan prepared by Lawhon & Associates and approved by the Ohio School Facilities Commission effective October 10, 2012.
- (C) The Board authorizes the use of the maintenance funds for permitted uses related to the Western Reserve K-12 School as described in the Maintenance Plan.
